MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT MEMORIAL JUNKET X "OUR LAST HURRAH"

Memorial Junket X is scheduled for September 8th - 13th, 2005 at the Marriott Hotel, Huntingdon, England. During the 2004 Reunion's Business Meeting the Members voted to have another Memorial Junket, and this could be our LAST MEMORIAL JUNKET! Another vote was made on future Reunions, it was decided that our next Reunion in the U.S.A. would be on a smaller scale and we would call them, "Gatherings." More information on these will be forthcoming at a later date.

The Marriott Hotel is the same hotel we used for Memorial Junket IX, at that time it was a Swallow Hotel. We have contracted for 75 rooms and have negotiated an excellent room rate, especially for England: 80 British Pounds for Double Occupancy and 65 British Pounds for Single and this price includes Breakfast. The Marriott Hotel has made arrangements for an additional 25 rooms at a nearby Hotel. Transportation will be provided to and from this hotel and the Marriott.

As is done for all of our Reunions and Memorial Junkets, each person shall be responsible for making their hotel room reservations and for paying for their hotel room. The Memorial Junket Charges cover all of the Activities, ie; tours, lunches, transportation, banquets, etc.

There is a deadline of July 1st, 2005 for making your hotel room reservation at the Marriott Hotel, on this date the hotel rooms will be released. There will be no guarantee that you will be able to reserve a hotel room after July 1st, 2005.

A Deposit of \$200.00 per person shall be required to accompany the Registration Form, the balance of \$290.00 must be paid on or before July 1, 2005. This eliminates having registration in England, this allows you to pay by check, if we had registration in England, we could not accept checks and you would have to pay in British Pounds.

Wheel Chairs will be available at no charge on Saturday at the Duxford Air Museum. They have to be ordered in advance, so if you need one, let us know.

If you desire to be seated with your crew or friends at the Banquets, fill out and return the table reservation form.

RESERVATIONS, DEPOSITS FINAL PAYMENT & CANCELLATIONS:

All the Registrations must be accompanied by a Deposit of \$200.00 per person, or Full Payment, to be considered confirmed. Final Payment will be due and payable on July 1st, 2005.

NO EXCEPTIONS

This Policy is necessary because the 384th Bomb Group, Inc. is required to make Deposits, or Full Payments for the Functions for Memorial Junket X on or before July 1st, 2005.

HUNTINGDON MARRIOTT HOTEL RESERVATION REQUIREMENTS & INSTRUCTIONS

The Memorial Junket X Committee has reserved 75 rooms at the Huntingdon Marriott in England. The Marriott has also reserved an additional 25 rooms at a nearby Hotel in case they are needed.

THE MEMORIAL JUNKET X CHARGES DO NOT INCLUDE THE HOTEL ROOM. Each person is responsible for making their Hotel Room Reservation and paying for same.

The room rate for a Single Occupancy, including Breakfast is: 65.00 British Pounds.

The room rate for a Double Occupancy, including Breakfast is: 80.00 British Pounds.

The dates for Memorial Junket X are: September 8th - 13th, 2005.

You can book a room at this room rate for two day prior to Memorial Junket X and for two days following Memorial Junket X. The 384th Bomb Group has a contract for 75 rooms for Sept. 8th - 13th, 2005, the two days prior and the two days following do not come under the contract guarantee, but based upon availability you can reserve your room for those extra 4 days at the 384th Bomb Group rate, to make sure you get the extra days, it would be advisable to make your room reservation EARLY!

To make your Hotel Room reservation, telephone the Marriott Hotel Central Reservations: 1-800-228-9290. Be sure you make the room reservation for the: Huntingdon Marriott Hotel, Kingfisher Way, Hinchingbrooke Business Park, Huntingdon, Cambridgeshire, England. Also, when making your room reservation, please tell the Marriott Reservation person to let the Huntingdon Marriott Hotel know that you are a member of the 384th Bomb Group Association attending the Memorial Junket X.

You can also make your room reservation by calling the Marriott Hotel direct. The Local Telephone Number is: 0870-400-7257. (Yoù will be required to add the Country Code to this number, which is: 011-44-870-400-7257.





From the South (A1) follow A14 East to Cambridge, Huntingdon and M11. Pass Brampton Racecourse and at the next roundabout the hotel is on the right.

From the North (A1) take the A14 East to Cambridge, Huntingdon and M11. Exit the A14 towards Huntingdon. At the roundabout turn right on to the A14 West. The hotel will be on your left.

From the Midlands J19 (M1) M6 follow A14 to Huntingdon. Pass Brampton Racecourse. Continue as from the South. From Cambridge M11 follow A14 North, turn off for Brampton racecourse and M1/M6. At the roundabout the hotel will be on the left.
