My dad was wounded on his 13th mission, and while recovering, his plane and companions were shot down and lost. If not for that hunk of shrapnel, I would not be here writing this. These men all flew what is, in my opinion, the most effective bomber ever: the B-17. There were 17 of these men of the Greatest Generation with us for a memorable visit in Dayton.

HEALTH Is Our Most POWERFUL WEAPON



From aerial combat in 1943 to Belfonds, France today... Lt Clifford Dartt's B-17, NYMOKYMI, led by Lt Gordon Erickson, was shot down on 4 July 1943 over Belfonds, France. Soon afterwards, Clifford was taken prisoner and was a POW until the end of the war. Four from his crew, including Gordon, evaded capture and were back in the US well before war's end.

Through the 384th website and newsletters, Clifford's son-in-law, Mark Olson, made contact with Sally Sorel of Belfonds. Sally helped Mark with information about Clifford's time about his capture. Unfortunately today Clifford suffers from dementia, but Sally has been gracious in filling in the memory gaps. Clifford was delighted to meet Sally and Danny Sorel in July, and seemed truly appreciative of their work in preserving the history and memory of him and his crew following their crash on 4 July 1943. The Sorels are equally grateful to have found Clifford, who is such a notable figure in the history of Belfonds back in 1943.

Another bit of closure occurred on 31 July 2015, when Ray Lustig and Susan Taylor brought the 384th BG wing panel project to Clifford for his signature. Although suffering from Alzheimer's, he really tuned in to the occasion and appreciated the recognition. Thanks to all who help keep alive the history and memory of our WW II heroes

PIMA AIR MUSEUM TOUR - FRIDAY, OCTOBER 30

We will arrive and enjoy a group lunch before exploring the museum. View models, uniforms, insignia, WWII mock-up airmen's quarters, a B-29 "Superfortress," Douglas 'Globemaster,' F-84 "Shooting Star," F-100 "Super Sabre," SR-71, and a pristinely restored B-17. There are over 250 planes on display including JFK's Air Force One. Trace America's heritage of flight from a full-scale replica of the Wright brothers' plane to the X-15 rocket that first took men to the edge of space. Following the Museum visit, enjoy the aircraft static display before returning to the hotel.

SABINO CANYON TOUR - SATURDAY, OCTOBER 31

Enjoy lunch at Sweet Tomatoes, which features an Italian Buffet. 
