Amended Instructions Concerning Publicity in Connection with Escaped Prisoners of War, to Include Evaders of Capture in Enemy or Enemy-Occupied Territory and Internees in Neutral Countries.

- Publication or communication to any unauthorized persons of experiences of escape or evasion from enemy-occupied territory, internment in a neutral country, or release from internment not only furnishes useful information to the enemy but also jeopardizes future escapes, evasions and
- Personnel will not, unless authorized by the Assistant Chief of Staff, G-2, War Department General Staff, publish in any form whatever or communicate either directly, or indirectly, to the press, radio or an unauthorized person any account of escape or evasion of capture from enemy or enemy-occupied territory, or internment in a neutral country either before or after repatriation. They will be held strictly responsible for all statements contained in communications to friends which may subsequently be published in the press or otherwise.
- Evaders, escapees, or internees shall not be interrogated on the circumstances of their experiences in escape, evasion or internment except by the agency designated by the Assistant Chief of Staff, G-2, War Department General Staff, or the corresponding organization in overseas theaters of operations. In allied or neutral countries, American Military Attaches are authorized to interrogate on escape, evasion and internment matters.
- Should the services of escaped prisoners of war, evaders, or internees be deemed necessary for lecturing and briefing, such services will be under the direct supervision of the agency designated by the Assistant Chief of Staff, G-2, War Department General Staff, or the corresponding organiza-
- Commanding Officers will be responsible for instructing all evaders, escapees, and internees in the provisions of this directive which supersedes letter, AG 383.6 (5 Nov 42) OB-S-B-M, 7 November 1942, subject: Instructions concerning Publicity in Connection with Escaped Prisoners of War and other previous instructions on this subject.

- Information about your escape or your evasion from capture would be useful to the enemy and a danger to your friends. It is therefore SEGRET.
- You must therefore not disclose, except to the first Military Attache to whom you report, or to an officer designated by the Commanding General of the Theater of Operations, or by A. C. of S., G-2, W. D.
  - (1) The names of those who helped you.
  - (2) The method by which you escaped or evaded.
  - (3) The route you followed.
  - (4) Any other facts concerning your experience.
  - You must be particularly on your guard with persons representing the press.
  - You must give no account of your experiences in books, newspapers, periodicals or in broadcasts or in lectures.
- You must give no information to anyone, irrespective of nationality, in letters or in conversation, except as specifically directed in Par. 4. No lectures or reports are to be given to any unit without the permission of A. C. of S., G-2, W. D., or corresponding organization in the theater.

I understand that any information concerning my escape or evasion from capture is SEGRET and must not be disclosed to anyone other than the agency designated by A. C. of S., G-2, War Department, the corresponding organization in overseas theaters of operations, or to the Military Attache in a neutral country to whom I first report. When he went into Swity he had written intelligence reports from Daniel & Broshar, and to own reports on such mallers a radar, airfields, flak untallations troop concentrations and morements. Was never interrogeted at Berne, but told to make out a written report, which was given to La Rexford, ofMA Berne. One of his assts read report + suggested Butter see Brit dir attathe ( Carah). 2334 1st Lt. J.A. BUTLER I was pilot of a B-17 Shot down about 10 miles east of RENNES on 16 Sept 43. I hid for 3 days in a farm house from where I contacted and organization man in LA ROUAUDIERE 18 Km NE of CHATEAUBRIANT, who tried to make connections for me to get to Spain He was a school teacher, and worked for the German authorities in Town. He 5 10" tall, stocky, 35 years old, had dark hair and was cleant clean cut and well dressed in appearance. Mother organization member there known to the above, is helieved to be the mayor of the town. Thile dealing with these people I was playing at a peasant's house about 1 Km W of La Robantière. I was there 11/2 days, Then I went on foot towards Spain, as the Organization did not seem very helpful. after 2 weeks walking I was mable to cross The Loire so I beturned to La Ronandiere, The organization chief at SABLÉ had been killed by Gestapo, so the organin man described above contacted another organization at MAYENNE. "Capt BROSHAR" (This spelling is according to pronunciation. French spelling may be "BROCHARD" or "BREAUCHARD"

was The man contacted. I then went to ANDVILLE with the Doctor of that town. He and his son kept in touch with the organization. He was a rich man. 60-65 years old, wore a goatee, drove his own car. His son was about 22 years old, heavy, had curly hair, spoke English. This was about 3 October 43. From here I went to a farm hetween MARTIGNÉ and SOSSE (about 3 Km W of MARTIGNE). I helieve the owner's name was TIMOS. He has two pour 20 and 23 years old. One speaks some English. Capt BROSHAR's" assistant was also there - a boy of about 18 or 19 named DANIEL. Daniel took me, after 4 days, on a train through Paris to WITRY, 6 Km NE of RHEIMS. I stayed with a man named LANIER in this town for 3 or 4 days. Alla brother washer. His brother-in-law, a one-legged man, made

Contact with an organization at PONTARLIER. I then went to Pontarlier with Daniel, where spent 12 days in an apartment with GEORGES COIFFIER, who works in the Railroad office in town. From here a baker of PONTARLIER named LEVENFELDT took me to a village near the border, where an old man known to him took me across into Switzerland. when I reported to the Military attache at Berne I had written reports from Daniel and Capt Broshar, as well as many of my own, on radar, airfields, flak installations, troop concentrations and movements. I was never interrogated by the intelligence officer, but was told to water a written reports turn in my written reports to It. REXFORD, of the attachés office. One of his assistants read the reports and suggested I give them to the British air attaché. I did so and he was very interested and interviewed me at length. From 6 to 13 September, I acted as Liaison officer to General between Gen.
