

BAIL OUT, JUST BEFORE I LEFT. HE SEEMED TO BE UNINJURED

REASON I THINK HE HIT THE GROUND OK. - AFTER BEING CAPTURED

I WAS TAKEN TO A SMALL TOWN + HELD FOR A COUNE OF MOURS.

AROUT 1700 HOURS - A GERMAN TRUCK ARRIVED + I WAS LOADED ON THE
BACK WITH FELECETTI (TAIL ONNER) IN THIS TRUCK (ILTON) WERE LOADED
THREE CASKETS ALONG WITH OPENED PARACHUTES + OTHER COUITINES

FROM OUR PLANE I IMMEDIATELY RECOGNIZED MY COVERALLS + FELECETTIS

A-2 JACKET. IT APPEARED THAT THEY HAD JUST CLEANED UP THE
WEERKAGE OF OUR SHIP (OGS). AFTER RIPING ABOUT 30 MIN. ONE OF
THE CASKETS WAS UNLOADED AT A SMALL TOWN. THE OTHER TWO CASKETS
ACCOMPANIED US TO AN A PRISON AT AN AIRFIELD PRESUMABLY

NEAR MUNICH.

TALKING THE MATTER OVER WITH THE OTHER BOTS LATER- THE ENGINEER SAID THE MAIN PART OF THE BLAST WAS CONTERED IN THE NAVIGATOR'S POSITION, THUS PROBABLY KILLING THE TOGGLIER + NAVIGATOR INSTRUMELY, & ERITICALLY INSURING THE CO-PILET (OR POSTICING POSITION). THESE THREE MEN, AND NOT TO MY KNOWLEDGE, BAILLY OUT

THEN THESE THREE MEN ACCORDING TO MY REASONING WERE IN THE THREE CASKETS MENTIONED ABOVE. THIS LETS GRIFFIN OUT AS TO THE POSSIBLISH OF WIM CRASHING WITH THE SHIP. WHAT HAPPENED TO HIM AFTER HE HIT THE AROUND I DON'T KNOW BECAUSE I DIDN'T SEE HIM AGAIN. GRIFFIN BAILED OUT ONCE BOFORE OVER ENGLAND-30 IT SEEMS IMPROBABLE THAT HE WOULD MESITATE TO SUMP.
