

384thBombGroup.com Standard Operating Procedure

Procedure: Add New Aircraft Album To 384th Bomb Group Photo Gallery
Established: 17 November 2016
Updated: 25 June 2017, 11 January 2021

Assumption: Photo albums are hosted by Piwigo software on the 384thBombGroup.com server.
Prerequisite: Photo album for subject aircraft must not exist.

1) Purpose: Create a new aircraft album to contain images related to an aircraft, and link to its One384thAircraft page.

2) Procedure:

- a) Create Album.
 - i) Navigate to the appropriate Aircraft album – B-17F or B-17G.
 - ii) Confirm that no album exists for the tail number (they should be in numerical order).
 - iii) Select **Edit → Properties Page** from the top menu bar.
 - iv) Select **manage sub-albums**.
 - v) Select **create a new album**.
 - vi) Enter the following four data items in the blank provided for **Album name**:
 - (1) B-17x (x is F or G), followed by a Space
 - (2) Serial number, followed by a Space
 - (3) Squadron code, followed by a Comma and a Space
 - (4) Name, UPPERCASE, in quotation marks (double quotes), or **Unnamed**, mixed case without quotes.
 - (a) Example: **B-17G 42-97251 BK*O, "SNUFFY"**
 - vii) Select **Create** to complete creation of the new album.
- b) Edit album **Description**.
 - i) Select the **Edit** option below the new album name in the list.
 - ii) Enter general descriptive and historical information about the aircraft in the blank provided for **Description**.
 - (1) Note: Refer to standard operating procedure **Photo Album Name and Description SOP**.
 - iii) When complete, select **Save Settings**.
- c) Move album to proper position.
 - i) Return to the **manage sub-albums** B-17F or G page.
 - ii) Drag the new album to its proper place in numerical order.
 - iii) Select **Save manual order** to make that change permanent.
- d) Create Permalink (permits page scripts to automatically generate link to album).
 - i) Select **Administration** from left menu.
 - ii) Expand the Albums topic at left and select **Manage**.
 - iii) Select the **Permalinks** tab.
 - iv) Select **"Add/delete a permalink"**
 - v) Locate the album just created in the **Album** pull-down menu and click on it.
 - vi) Enter the aircraft model (F or G) followed by the serial number in the **Permalink** box.
 - vii) Select the **Submit** button to complete the operation.
- e) Update Aircraft table record to enable automatic display of album link.
 - i) Find the database record for the aircraft in the Aircraft table.
 - ii) Edit the record.
 - iii) Enter the digit 1 (one) in the **AlbumExists** field.
 - iv) Select **Go** to complete the database update.
