Timeline

1245 Luftwaffe Alert to Take Off and assemble over Paderborn, then fly cover over Frankfurt Fighter Groups 1 and 11

1320 - 1350 1st Sq FG 1 attacks head-on with 15 Fw-190s and shoots down first Tollison and then the Lead Stearns/Bedsole

with 22 Me-109G-6s, drawing off P-47 escort;
Then 1st Sq FG 1 attacks the low sqdn (545th)
with three heavily armed Fw-190A-7s backed
up by 15 Fw-190A-6s
Six B-17s are shot down in less than three
minutes: Fioretti, Briley, Heffley, Poole,
Swanson and Miller














