

**Internet Hosting MOU for
384th Bomb Group, Inc. (hereafter: "Group") Content
on 384thBombGroup.com (hereafter: "Website")**

The Website has hosted Group-specific web pages since early 2007. Since that time, there has been no description of the relationship between the Group and the Website. This Memorandum of Understanding records the *de facto* parameters of this relationship in effect in February 2019.

1. Responsibility.
 - a. The Website exists solely to preserve and present as complete a history of 384th Bombardment Group (Heavy) operation in, and shortly after, WWII as possible.
 - b. The Website is an operation independent of all other organizations.
 - c. The Website is wholly owned and financed by the Webmaster.
 - d. The Website is not responsible for the actions, statements, or financial obligations of the Group or its members acting on its behalf.
 - e. The Group is not responsible for any content presented on the Website.
 - f. The Website assumes responsibility for the content of these web pages.
 - g. The Webmaster has final authority over content published on the website.
2. Services
 - a. The Website will establish and maintain a portion of the 384th Website exclusively for the benefit of the Group.
 - b. The Website will create, publish, and maintain up to ten permanent web pages and up to three temporary web pages containing information pertaining to the Group's status, plans, and activities.
 - c. Group pages will use the same layout design as, but will have a distinctly different color scheme from, the historical portion of the Website.
 - d. The Group may provide content for new pages, revisions to existing pages, or request removal of individual pages, within the limitations specified.
 - e. The Group may specify time limitations on the public availability of content provided, and the Website will use its best efforts to adhere to the limits given.
 - f. All content accepted for publication on the Website will be governed by the Fair Use Policy as posted on the SITE INFO→Site Policies page, and will be viewable by all website visitors.
 - g. All content received by the Website will be examined for the presence of potentially hazardous inclusions.
 - h. Information will be placed on these web pages by Website staff members.
 - i. Website tasks will be accomplished by Website staff as time becomes available.
3. Termination: The Group or the Website may elect to terminate the hosting arrangement at any time. If this occurs, the Website will deliver the page files to the Group for possible future use of the content: however, the page design may not be used elsewhere.
