May 26, 1943 - the First 384th Bombardment Group (H) B-17s' land at Station 106, Grafton Underwood, England.

June 3, 1943 - the 384th Bombardment Group (H) Ground Echelon arrive at Station 106, Grafton Underwood, England.

June 22, 1943 - 384th Bombardment Group (H) B-17s' take off on their First Combat Mission from Station 106, Grafton Underwood, England.

To CELEBRATE the 50TH ANNIVERSARY of these HISTORICAL EVENTS MEMORIAL JUNKET VII is scheduled for:

DATES: May 19th to May 24th, 1993.

HEADQUARTERS: Holiday Inn, Leicester, England.

EVENTS ARE SCHEDULED AT: Leicester, Hatfield, Grantham, Grafton Underwood, Kettering, Cambridge, and Duxford.

The November 1992 Newsletter had the announcement about MEMORIAL JUNKET VII. Included was an INFORMATION FORM that was to be returned to Lloyd Whitlow by those people that were interested in attending MEMORIAL JUNKET VII. The response was excellent and much better than expected. Each person that sent us an INFORMATION FORM was mailed the MEMORIAL JUNKET VII PACKET, 150 PACKETS were mailed.
