"D" DAY 50TH ANNIVERSARY MEMORIAL SERVICE

On June 4, 1994, a D-Day 50th Anniversary Memorial Service was held at the Cambridge American Cemetery and Memorial at Cambridgeshire, England. Lloyd Whitlow made the trip to England to attend this historical event as the Representative of the 384th Bombardment Group(H). Also in attendance for the historical program were our Honorary Members, Quentin Bland and Brian Goodman. The key people in the program were the Right Honorable John Major, Prime Minister of England, the President of the United States, Bill Clinton, the Honorable Lloyd Bentsen, Secretary of the Treasury, and Walter Cronkite. Lloyd Bentsen flew 35 Combat Missions with the 15th Air Force during WWII. The program ended with a Fly-By/ Missing Man Formation of F-16's and a B-17, P-51, and Spitfire.


